Hearst is the curator of the museum's FOCUS exhibition series and has presented exhibitions of artists including Fred Tomaselli, Joyce Pensato, Thomas Demand, and Lorna Simpson. She is currently working on exhibitions with Stanley Whitney and Katherine Bernhardt for 2017. Hearst also organized *Donald Sultan: The Disaster Paintings*, which opens at the Modern in February and travels to several other venues. Hearst received a MA in Art History from Texas Christian University and a BFA in Art History from the University of North Texas.

Justine Ludwig is the Director of Exhibitions/ Senior Curator at Dallas Contemporary. In recent years she has curated exhibitions at the Contemporary Arts Center in Cincinnati, the Tufts University Art Gallery, and the Museum of Modern Art in Rio de Janeiro. Her research interests include memory, new media, architecture, economics, and the aesthetics of globalization. Ludwig holds an MA in Global Arts from Goldsmiths University of London.

After graduating from Smith College, Talley Dunn returned to Dallas and immediately began working with the contemporary art community as an art dealer.
