

CODE OF CONDUCT



NO SMOKING OR VAPING

Prairie Mall is a smoke-free establishment in compliance with all government legislation. Smoking or vaping is not permitted within 60 feet of any entrance or covered area. **This includes marijuana and associated products due to be legalized by governments in October, 2018.**



PERSONAL MOBILITY DEVICES

Personal mobility devices, motorized wheelchairs and medical scooters must be operated at low speeds to ensure the safety of all visitors.



RECREATIONAL MOBILITY DEVICES

Cycling, rollerblading, skateboarding and hoverboarding are not permitted on the premises.



APPROPRIATE ATTIRE

Appropriate attire must be worn while inside the shopping centre. Attire that may be considered objectionable, constitutes a disguise, hoods, and/or is intended to conceal identity is not permitted.



BE CONSIDERATE

Refrain from any behaviour which may interfere with the enjoyment of the shopping centre for patrons and tenants but not limited to running, biking, skateboarding, rollerblading, littering, profane language, mischief, vandalism, and the unsafe use of elevators and escalators is prohibited. Any act that violates Municipal, Provincial or Federal laws or regulations is prohibited.



NO PETS

Except for service animals.



NO PHOTOS

Photo and/or video devices may only be used with prior approval from centre management.



NO SOLICITING

Distributing literature/soliciting of any kind is strictly prohibited. Pre-approval exceptions from shopping centre management may apply.



CCTV SURVEILLANCE

Prairie Mall reserves the right to take pictures on the premises for marketing purposes. To assist and protect our patrons and tenants CCTV systems have been implemented.



PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Personal entertainment and electronic devices may only be operated within accepted locations and volume levels.

Complimentary Wi-Fi is available for guests of Prairie Mall throughout the mall. Seating is available in designated areas. Please limit usage to 20 minutes during busy times. No loitering permitted.
